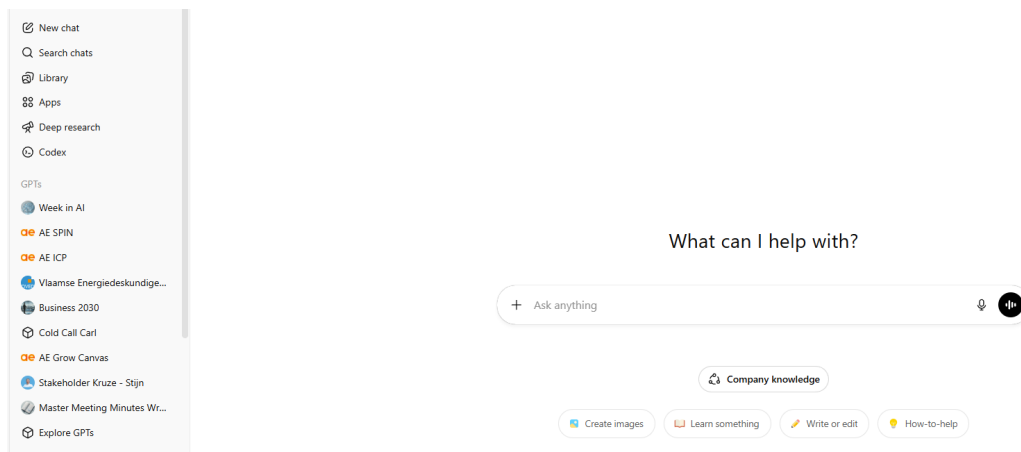


Do I have the right license for the course?

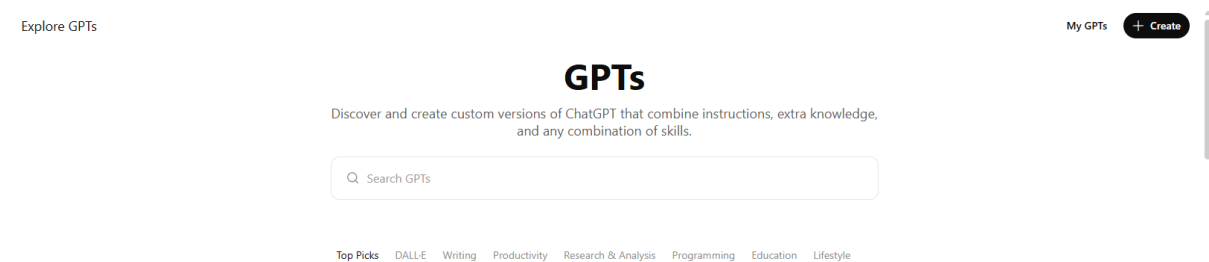
Although you can get far with the free license, some things are impossible to achieve without it. I would say 85% is possible in the course, 15 % will be a challenge. Mainly the last part about building custom GPTs, Gems or Agents.

How to check if you use ChatGPT?

On the ChatGPT.com website, go to Explore GPTs in the menu on the left, bottom of the screen on this screenshot

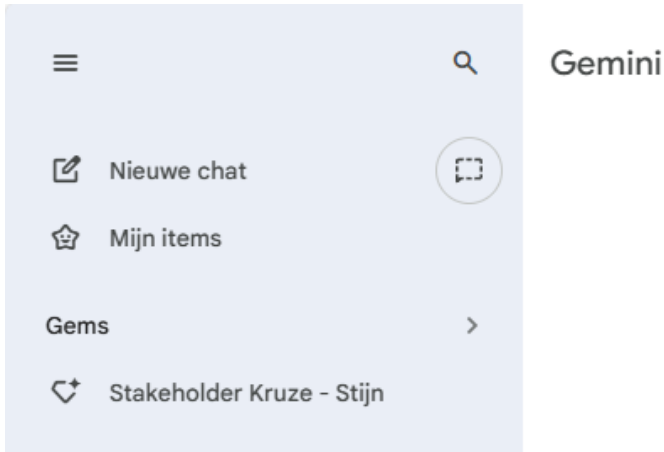


If you have the right license, on the next screen you should see a create button on the right. If not, you don't have the right license. Usually if you pay for ChatGPT, you can see that create button.



How to check if you use Gemini?

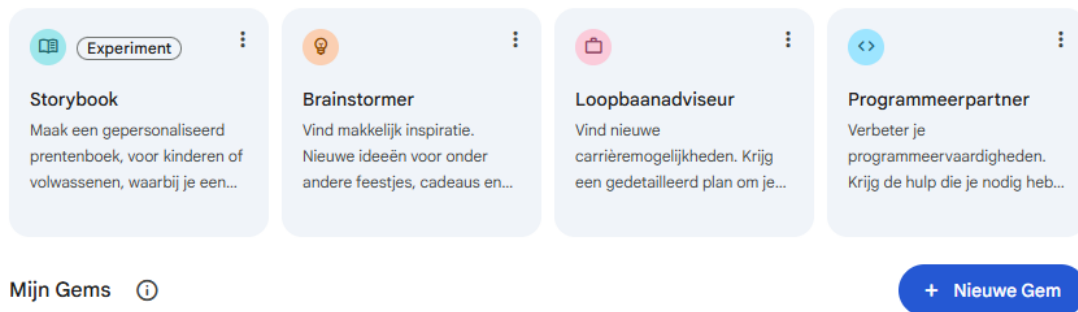
Click on the arrow next to gems in the left navigation to go to the gems overview



On the gems screen, you should see a create button. If so, you are good to go

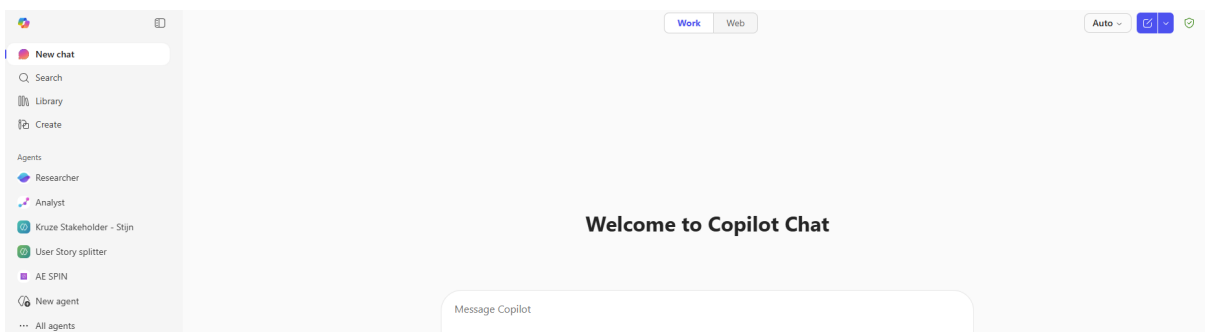


How to check if you use Copilot?

Copilot is the most difficult one of them all. With the others it is pretty straightforward, if you pay you are good to go.

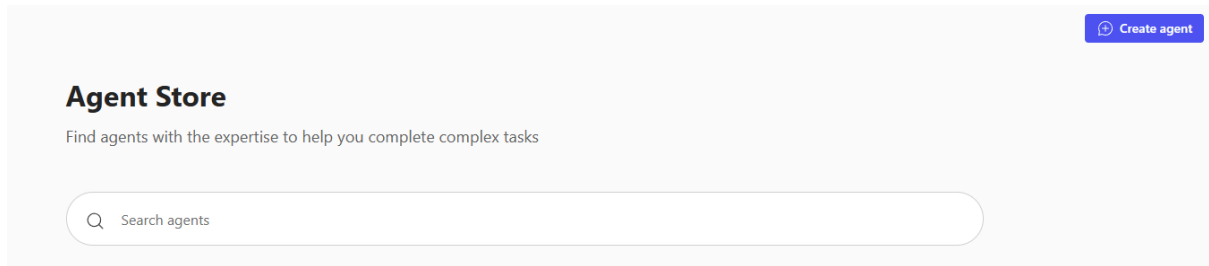
However, Microsoft made it a bit more difficult, and it can that you pay for a Microsoft license and can use copilot, however not the version in which you can create Copilot Agents. For that you need to have an additional paid subscription.

When you log into copilot, you should see on top of the screen a possibility to select work or web.



If you don't, you are on a version for which no additional subscription is paid. Another test is to go to all agents on the left menu.

You should see a create button on top of the screen



If so, good to go.
